State Contracts

- Six major contract programs
 - Food Inspection (42 States)
 - Feed/BSE Inspection (35 States)
 - Tissue Residue Inspection (18 States)
 - MQSA Inspection (47 States)
 - Milk Drug Residue Database
 - Medical Devices Inspection (1 State)

State Contracts, continued

- Contracts with over 145 state regulatory agencies
- Over 25,000 inspections
- Over 4 million samples

Grants and Cooperative Agreements

- 4 existing grants and cooperative agreements
 - Ruminant Feed Ban Support Project
 - Food Safety and Security Monitoring Project
 - HIV Health Fraud
 - Food Defense Task Force

Commissioning State Officials

- Provides authority to state officials to conduct investigations and collect samples to enforce FFD&C Act
- More than 600 officials are commissioned

Voluntary Work Agreements

- Partnership Agreements with states
 - Agreement with NY Department of Health for regulation of new x-ray assemblies
- MOUS with states
 - MOU with South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control to conduct certifiers program under MQSA
- Coordinated Operations Plan for Emergencies (COPE)
 - Coordinate planning, preparation, response, recovery

Manufactured Food Regulatory Programs Standards (5/2007)

- In 2007, 5 states piloted the program
- In 2008, it will be offered to all states under contract program
- 10 standards that establish critical elements of food safety regulatory program
- Inspection Audit Program to assess effectiveness of state program
- Comprehensive self-assessment
